Before traveling abroad, make sure to:



**GET INFORMED** about your destination at [travel.state.gov/destination](https://travel.state.gov/destination), and plan for the unexpected at [travel.state.gov/crisis](https://travel.state.gov/crisis).



**GET REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**, such as your passport and visas.



**GET ENROLLED** in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) at [step.state.gov](https://step.state.gov) to receive security and emergency alerts.



**GET INSURED** for medical, evacuation, and other unexpected expenses.



**Carry this card with you when you go abroad.**
