Q: Is Morehouse planning to operate programs abroad during Spring 2022?

A: Yes, Morehouse is planning to operate programs abroad during Spring 2022. The safety of our students, faculty, and staff is our top priority. We will continue to monitor the Covid-19 pandemic closely and will follow guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the U.S. Department of State, and the University System of Georgia.

Q: If I appy for a program but I do not have a passport yet, can I get help from OIE?

A: Yes, our Fall 2021 Passport Assistance Program will help you. In addition to assisting you with the passport application, we also provide \$100 in financial support for your passport. You have to submit your receipt of application via our website as soon as possible. Once the submission threshold is met, the application portal will close. See application, here.

Charles Norton is a Visiting Assistant Professor of Modern Foreign Languages. He earned a PhD in Aesthetics from Paris Nanterre University in December 2020. He is preparing monographs in French and English based on his research in education and social engagement in global Hip Hop cultures. Prior to joining Morehouse College, he was a full-time faculty at the University of Arizona, Arizona State University, and the University of Paris. He held temporary positions at the University of Rwanda, the American Language Center in Morocco, Pima County Community College, and Off the Beaten Track anthropology field school in Malta.
